Code of Conduct

Chorley Tennis Club Junior Players are expected to abide by the following:

- 1. Members must play by the rules and respect coaches and adult volunteers and their decisions.
- 2. Members must respect their peers and opponents.
- 3. Members should keep to agreed timings for coaching and inform their coach if they are going to be late or cannot attend.
- 4. Members must wear suitable kit including non-marking tennis shoes and pay fees promptly.

Guidelines for parent adult volunteers and coaching staff.

- 1. Discourage unfair play and arguing.
- 2. Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performance of all.
- 3. Help players to recognise good performance (not just results) and never belittle a player for losing or making mistakes.
- 4. Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
