Code of Conduct

Chorley Tennis Club Junior Players are expected to abide by the following:

1. Members must play by the rules and respect coaches and adult volunteers and their decisions.
2. Members must respect their peers and opponents.
3. Members should keep to agreed timings for coaching and inform their coach if they are going to be late or cannot attend.
4. Members must wear suitable kit including non-marking tennis shoes and pay fees promptly.

Guidelines for parent adult volunteers and coaching staff.

1. Discourage unfair play and arguing.
2. Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performance of all.
3. Help players to recognise good performance (not just results) and never belittle a player for losing or making mistakes.
4. Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
